He serves on the faculty at Southern Methodist University's Meadows School of the Arts, where he teaches percussion and directs the Meadows World Music Ensemble. ### **The Ismaili Muslim Cultural Group**

The Ismaili Muslim Cultural Group enacting the story of “Two Crafty Jackals, The Animal Fables of Kalilah and Dimnah” written by Elizabeth Laird and published by the Aga Khan Museum. Kalilah and Dimnah first appeared in the Panchatantra (Sanskrit for Five Principles), composed in India in the third century BC, related a series of nested tales within tales to illustrate examples of right or wrong behavior that lead to good or bad results. These stories were then translated into Arabic and Persian, traveled to many countries before arriving in Europe and translated into many European languages.

### **Salaam Dabkeh Troupe**

Salaam Dabkeh Troupe is a traditional Middle-Eastern folkloric dance troupe. Their message is to spread cultural awareness through dancing 'dabkeh'. Their directive is peace! The stomping represents the passion they have for their country of Palestine. The holding of the hands exemplifies the unity they feel for their country and other countries. Their goal is one of peace through community outreach.

### **The Zevk Ensemble**

The Zevk Ensemble is the combined effort of husband and wife team Benyamin and Rabia van Hattum. Zevk is a Turkish word conveying taste and joy coming from an uplifted heart.
